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Behold the Lamb

Now Yahweh had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights. - Jonah 1:17



For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. - Matthew 12:40

Blinded eyes which cannot see due to unbelief; professing a belief and yet stumbling in the way of darkness which is clouded by the tradition of men. Yeshua said he would give but one sign — the sign of Jonah who spent three days and three nights in the whale's belly, so would Yeshua spend three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

The wise men of the world who profess to be biblical scholars have a counting problem or choose to follow after their father, satan, who is a liar and deceiver. They say Yeshua was put to death on a Friday and rose on Sunday, saying that any part of a day counts as a whole. But even in this reasoning there is a counting problem, for no way, no how are there three days and three nights found in a Friday crucifixion and a Sunday resurrection. Count it for yourself! After all, how hard could it be?

The key to understanding this engima is in understanding the Passover and the seven days of unleavened bread which follows (Leviticus 23:5-8) — Passover day being the preparation day

spoken of in John 19:31 — the day when the lambs were examined and slaughtered. It was also the day when all leaven was removed in preparation for the following seven days of unleavened bread. The first and last of the seven days are reckoned as high days wherein no servile work is permitted. Though not rising to the level of the weekly Sabbath, only later were they referred to as sabbath days.

"The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain on the stake on the Sabbath day, (for that sabbath day was an high day,) besought Pilate that their legs might be broken, and that they might be taken away." — John 19:31

As one's birthday may fall on a Tuesday one year and Thursday the next, so it is with Passover with the day of its observance changing from one year to the next, but the date of Passover never changes, being the 14th day of Nisan (Abib). As recorded in the 2000 year calendar in the Calendar of Festivals, Passover observance in 31 CE was on a Wednesday.

* Scriptural days begin at sundown. The first night and day would be Thursday, the second night and day Friday, and the third night and day Sabbath.

It was sometime before sunset on the weekly Sabbath (Saturday) that Yeshua rose from the tomb, for Scripture says in John 20:1-2, "The first day of the week came Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and saw the stone taken away from the sepulchre. Then she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciples, whom Yeshua loved, and said unto them, They have taken away the master out of the sepulchre, and we know not where they have laid him."

The tomb was empty, Yeshua had already risen. He did not rise on Sunday morning for that would have been day four. And yet the blind leaders continue to walk in darkness perpetuating the lies told of old. And to exasperate the truth even further, they promote the Sunday sunrise service followed by an Easter egg hunt which became embedded by the tradition of men, saying, "It's for the children".

It's time to awake, to walk in the light of truth, and put aside all that is not Scripturally sound, for the day of judgment is fast approaching.

"For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Yeshua Messiah. And you shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These are the words you shall speak unto the sons of Israel." — Exodus 19:5-6

"And you shall know that I have sent this commandment unto you, that my covenant might be with Levi, says Yahweh of hosts. My covenant was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my name. The Hebrew word Levi (לֵוִי, Strong's #3878) has the meaning: to be joined to; to adhere to. It was the name given to one of Jacob's sons and the sons of Levi were / are called Levites. It was when Israel went astray, demanding that Aharon

make a molten calf, that Moses asked, "Who is on Yahweh's side?" Only the sons of Levi responded and came to him. (Exodus 32:26) Both Moses and Aharon were Levites and Yahweh used them to deliver Israel from Egyptian bondage, therefore the sons of Levi were assigned the task of bearing the ark as priests of Yahweh.

"At that time Yahweh separated the tribe of Levi, to bear the ark of the covenant of Yahweh, to stand before Yahweh to minister to him, and to bless in his name, unto this day. Wherefore Levi has no part nor inheritance with his brethren; Yahweh is his inheritance, according as Yahweh your Elohim promised him." — Deuteronomy 10:8-9

To have Yahweh as one's inheritance is a blessing above all blessings, if only one will remain faithful and adherent.

"And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean. And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; and they shall judge it according to my judgments: and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in my assemblies; and shall hallow my sabbaths." — Ezekiel 44:23-24

But among those doing the work of Yahweh, some have went astray, and others professing to have a calling are nothing but imposters.

And it shall come to pass, that in what tribe the stranger dwells, there shall you give him his inheritance, says my Sovereign Yahweh."

And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints," Revelation 19:7-8.

The Hidden Revealed

"The wicked cannot find. The righteous must dig. It is in safety from the enemy." Dr. E.W. Bullinger

Oh, come, let us reason together; let us take a look and see the hidden treasure of Scripture. Let us lay aside all preconceived notions and indoctrination and examine the evidence revealed. May our hearts not be so hardened so to reject the testimony before us, but rather examine closely for validity and be willing to embrace the unveiled treasure.

The sacred names Yahweh and Yahshua are names of great importance. The gravity of these names become apparent with the reading of Joel 2:32, "And it shall come to pass, that whoever shall call on the name of Yahweh shall be delivered: ...," and Acts 4:12, "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." Herein we are shown the gateway for salvation. Because these names are so important and there is variance in the spelling of the Savior's name: Yeshua (יֵשׁוּעַ), Yahshua (יְהוֹשֻׁעַ, יֵשׁוּעַ), and Yahwehshua (יְהוֹשֻׁעַ יְהוָה, יֵשׁוּעַ יְהוָה), a quest was made so to validate the true and correct form one should use, that is if such validation could be found.

Since the names to be examined are Hebrew names and the Hebrew text of Scripture is the inspired word of Yahweh (not the translation therefrom), it is the Hebrew text that was examined. The method of examination employed was that used in Bible Code software where the Hebrew text is placed in a matrix and then viewed. Though not having either the software nor a computer at hand for such research, a method was devised for undertaking such study by hand. I herein share with you some of my findings which may be verified with a Hebrew Bible.

Do you have eyes to see and an understanding heart? Pray and ask Yahweh to let you see and understand the treasures now revealed. "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of Elohim, that gives to all men liberally, and unbraideth not; and it shall be given him," James 1:5.

Employing the Skip Letter Count (SLC), where the letters of the Savior's name appear encrypted in the Hebrew text at an equal distance, all forms spoken of were found in key verses (יִשְׁׁוֹ, יְהוֹשֻׁעַ, יְהוֹשֻׁעַ, יְהוֹשֻׁעַ, יְהוֹשֻׁעַ), thus giving validity to all forms. Examine the references listed. Provided are the starting point for beginning the letter count. The counting is always done from right to left as Hebrew is read. The longer forms (יְהוֹשֻׁעַ, יְהוֹשֻׁעַ) often appear in two parts, connected or very close together. In like manner, the form יְהוֹשֻׁעַ appears many times in two parts throughout the Hebrew text but these will not be the focus herein, with the exception of a few key verses.

The notation יְהוֹשֻׁעַ shows how the word appears in the text. If the dot appears on the left, the letters are in reverse, going left to right. A split notation יְהוֹשֻׁעַ for יְהוֹשֻׁעַ lets us know that the first three letters יְהוֹ (יְהוֹ) come first and the last three letters יִשְׁׁוֹ (יִשְׁׁוֹ) are intertwined and in reverse.

The majestic name of Yahweh, the Creator's memorial given to man for all generations (Exodus 3:15), is rejected by the masses, being despised and abhorred by the very ones professing belief in Scripture. Just how could this be? especially since Scripture says we are to glorify His name.

"So will I make My holy name known in the midst of My people Israel; and I will not (let them) pollute My holy name any more; and the heathen shall know that I am Yahweh, the Holy One in Israel." — Ezekiel 39:7

"You shall not lift up the name of Yahweh to falsehood (NIV), for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless that lifts up His name to falsehood (NIV)." — Exodus 20:7

"Unto you it was showed, that you might know that Yahweh He is Elohim; (there is) none else beside Him."
— Deuteronomy 4:35

"Look unto Me, and be you saved; all the ends of the earth: for I am El, and there is none else. I have sworn by Myself, the word is gone out of My mouth (in) righteousness, and shall not return. That unto Me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear." — Isaiah 45:22-23

In the name of Yahweh there is deliverance, and it is upon the name one must call, as Joel 2:32 instructs, "And it shall come to pass, (that) whosoever shall call on the name of Yahweh shall be delivered:..." Though the shortened form Yahshua (יְהוֹשֻׁעַ) of the Savior's name has the meaning of "Yahweh is salvation," the longer form of Yahwehshua (יְהוֹשֻׁעַ יְהוָה) goes a bit too far for some, even though Isaiah 43:11 clearly says, "I, even I,

(am) Yahweh, and beside Me (there is) no Savior." The name above all names which Acts 4:12 says, "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved."

"Wherefore Yahweh also has highly exalted Him, and given Him a name which is above every name. That at the name of Yahshua every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; and that every tongue should confess that Yahshua Messiah is Master, to the glory of Yahweh the Father." — Philippians 2:9-11

"You are worthy, O Yahweh, to receive glory and honor and power: for You have created all things, and for your pleasure they are and were created." — Revelation 4:11

Whether speaking of Yahweh the Father or Yahwehshua the Son, it is the name Yahweh which is praiseworthy being both the Creator and Savior.

"Giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. Turning now to Psalms 104:1 we read, "Bless Yahweh, O my Soul. O Yahweh my Elohim, You are very great; You are clothed with honor (תִּירוֹ) and majesty (הִדָּר)." And verse 31 reads, "The glory (תִּירוֹ) of Yahweh shall endure for ever: Yahweh shall rejoice in His works." It was the usage of the three Hebrew words translated as "honor" (תִּירוֹ hode #1935); "majesty" (הִדָּר hadar #1926); and "glory" (תִּירוֹ kabod #3519) which drew my attention to this chapter. In my curiosity I decided to put the Hebrew text into a matrix for examination. Using a seven column format the hidden treasure came to light.

Psalms 22

Bible codes — the encryption of words and phrases within the Hebrew Bible — though rejected by some for a number of reasons, what appears in Psalms 22 is something I find extraordinary. This psalm is one of prophetic content pertaining to Yāhwešhua's trial and death, written approximately 1042 BCE, over a thousand years before its fulfillment.

In the first verse of the English translation we read, "My El my El, why have you forsaken me? why are you so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?" The underlined portion are the very words Yāhwešhua spoke just before He died, as we are told in Matthew 27:46, which reads, "And about the ninth hour Yāhwešhua cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, my El, my El, why have You forsaken me?"

Taking a closer look by placing the Hebrew text into a matrix format of seven columns, the following was found:
